

BELGIAN CLUB RACING, 29 APRIL 2012

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Article 1 - Definition

Referring to the general provisions of the General Regulations Organisations VZW Terlamen 2012, a heat of the Belgian Gentlemen Driver's Club and Special Open Trophy, are run within the framework of the 'Belgian Club Racing'.

This meeting will be contested according to the FIA International Sporting Code and its appendices, the Sportive Regulations of the 2012 Championships concerned and the present Particular Regulations.

Modifications, amendments and/or changes to the present Particular Regulations will only be announced by means of dated and numerated Additives (published by the organizer or the stewards).

The Sportive Regulations 2012 are mentioned on www.racb.com for the Belgian Gentlemen Driver's Club and Special Open Trophy.

Article 2 - Eligible competitors and drivers

All competitors and drivers must be holders of a valid licence for circuits.

Competitors of European countries and other foreign competitors must be holders of a valid licence, of the same level as the Belgian licence with authorisation of their ASN and in accordance with RACB Sport, as mentioned in the general regulations of the FIA International Sporting Code.

Article 4 – Characteristics of the Event

BGDC

The 'Belgian Gentlemen Driver's Club', contested according to their own regulations, over one qualifying practice session of 50 minutes and one race of 150 minutes maximum.

SOT

The 'Special Open Trophy', contested according to their own regulations, over one free practice session of 60 minutes, one qualifying practice session of 20 minutes and one race of 160 minutes maximum.

The Panel of Stewards, in dialogue with the Race Director, has the right, in case of force majeure (accident, weather conditions, government decisions,...) to adapt the characteristics of the races and to change the time schedule, and this for free practice sessions, qualifying practice sessions, warm-ups and races.

The competitors are informed by means of a bulletin (new time schedule) that will be published on the official notice board (chequered stairs, at the entrance of the Race Control Center – Paddock Zone 2).

Article 5 – Numbers

The numbers must be affixed:

- on the front doors of the car;
- on the roof, central and directed to the front

Article 7 - Insurance

The insurers have made the necessary arrangements as foreseen in the current annual of RACB Sport. Every competitor can take a look at this insurance policy at the race secretariat.

The safety car may be brought into operation to neutralize a race upon the decision of the Race Director / Clerk of the Course. It will be used only if drivers or officials are in immediate physical danger, but the circumstances are not such as to necessitate suspending the race. The procedure of the operation will comply with the provisions specified in the FIA "General Prescriptions applicable to all FIA Championships, Challenges, Trophies and Cups and to their qualifying events run on circuits".

Protection against fire

In all vehicles which take part in competitions, there must be some form of protection between the engine and the driver's seat, suitable and sufficient, in the event of fire, for preventing the passage of flames.
